The House

The RSA's London House is 8 John Adam Street, close to Charing Cross Station.

The House is open every weekday 8.00am–10.00pm

It is closed at weekends, on public holidays, and between Christmas and the New Year: some facilities are closed during the summer holidays in August.

You are welcome to visit the House with guests as often as you wish. **Please bring your membership card** to check-in at Reception. There is a cloakroom on the ground floor.

Access for people with disabilities

All the public rooms in the House are accessible by wheelchair, and there are accessible toilets on the ground floor, +1 and –3. Both theatres have induction loops for the hard of hearing. Contact the Reception for guidance.

Conference facilities & private functions

The House is available for a wide range of private & commercial functions including meetings and seminars, conferences, weddings and private functions.

Rooms are available to hire during the day and evenings and we offer a full range of conference and catering facilities. Rooms can be hired weekends....Reduced rates apply to registered charities.

The House is licensed to hold civil wedding ceremonies, and is now the most popular private wedding venue in Westminster.
