4. Gift aid declaration

Gift Aid notes: 1. You must be a UK tax payer and pay an amount of UK income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the RSA and any other charities and CASCs that you donate to reclaims on your subscriptions and donations in the tax year (currently 25p for every £1)
2. If in future your circumstances change and you are no longer a UK taxpayer you should cancel your declaration. 3. Please notify the RSA should you change your name or address.
4. You can cancel the Gift Aid declaration at any time by notifying the charity. 5. If you pay income tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief via a self assessment tax return. You may want to consider donating this tax relief as an additional regular donation.
